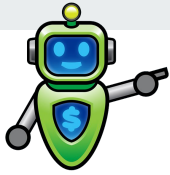

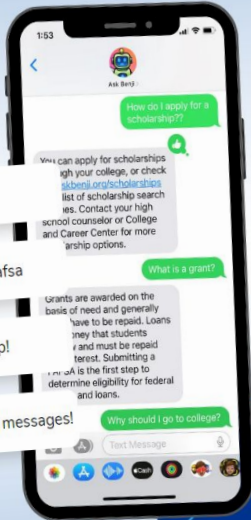

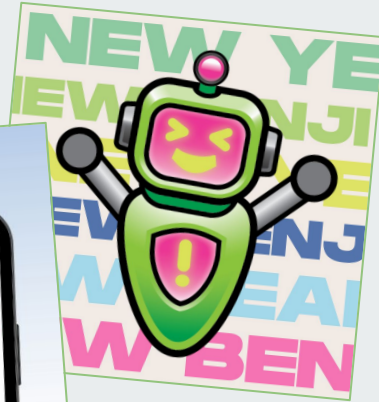

Arizona College Connect

- Innovative FAFSA database that provides authorized high school and district personnel with their student-level FAFSA information and other college attainment data.



The new data portal is funded by Helios Education Foundation and developed through a data partnership with the Arizona Department of Education.

A Case for Improvement

- Students who complete a FAFSA are [84% more likely](#) to enroll in a college or trade school 8immediately after high school.
- Schools that use this data on a consistent base have a 5% or higher FAFSA completion rate than schools that do not use this data.

AZGRANTS- FAFSA FINISH LINE DATA (former database)

Download Activity

- 252 schools/districts have a Data Sharing Agreement
- 49% have downloaded the data
- 42% have downloaded 5 or more times.
- 33% have downloaded 10 or more time

Challenges

- Accessing the data
- Time-consuming
- Limited high school resources/staff
- “I am not a data expert”
- File uploading difficulty
- What do we do with this data?

Setting up Access



Arizona College Connect is an interactive, customized communications portal providing high school leaders with access to students' **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** data and other college attainment information. Completing a FAFSA form is one of the strongest predictors of whether a student will pursue postsecondary education after high school.

This innovative new tool is made possible through funding from Helios Education Foundation and a data partnership with the Arizona Department of Education.

To gain access to the data:

1. High school principals need to sign a data-sharing agreement. If your school already has an agreement you can skip this step. [\(Click here to view a list of schools/districts with an agreement in place\)](#)
2. Once the data-sharing agreement is signed, authorized users can sign up to access the data.





- Data from ADE- uploaded once each school year
- All Seniors rosters can be edited by authorized high school and district users
- Delete or Add Student Records
- Adjust Enrollment Count and FAFSA Completion Rate
- Rosters will be loaded in November 2023
- The FAFSA will launch in December 2023

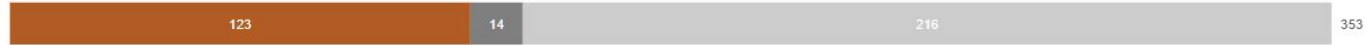
All Students by FAFSA Application Match Status

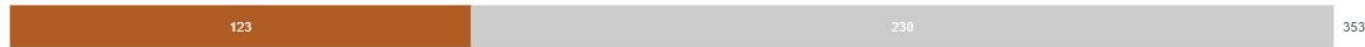
Matched FAFSA Applications by Application Status

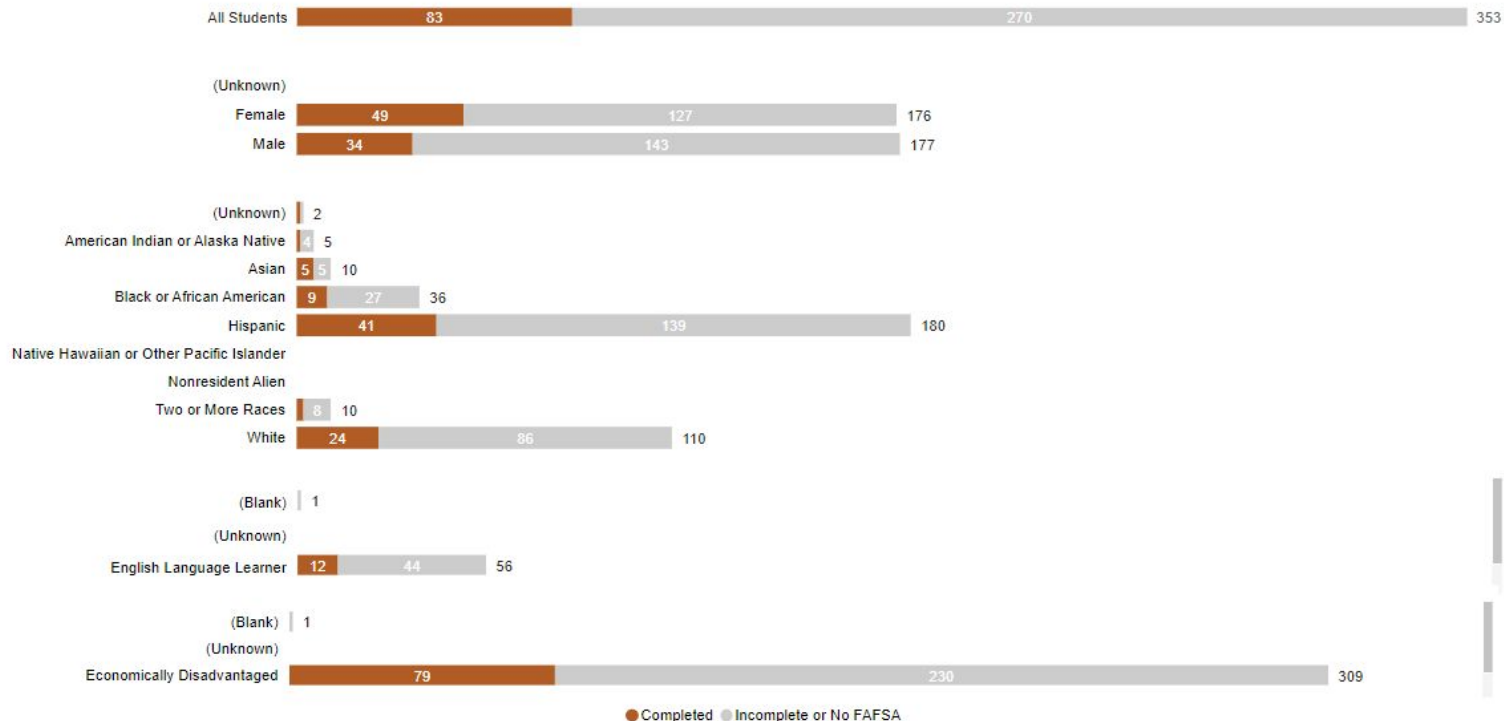

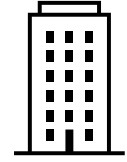




College Connect provides free advising services to assist students with their post-graduation goals and any college/career pathway.

We offer advising on campus, virtually and at the Tempe Public Library.

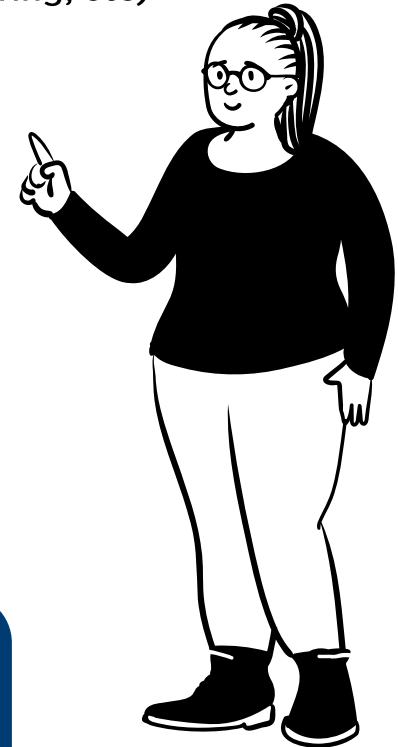
